SUMMARY

The City of Burlington has entered into an inter-local agreement with Skagit County to provide Advanced Life Support (ALS) and Basic Life Support (BLS) services in the City of Burlington and in portions of Skagit County effective January 1, 2019. Attached is a proposed fee resolution that would establish Emergency Medical Services (EMS) ambulance transport fees for the City of Burlington in accordance with Chapter 8.24.130 of the Burlington Municipal Code. This resolution, if adopted, would establish fees for EMS ambulance transport services. Attached is the current Skagit County Ambulance Fee Schedule, Resolution # 20170145, for your review.

SUMMARY

The City has entered into and Interlocal Agreement with Skagit County to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to City and County residents. Both Advanced Life Support (ALS) and Basic Life Support (BLS) services will be provided, including transportation to local hospitals as needed. Funding for this service will come from the Countywide EMS Levy (via the ILA), the City's General Fund, and Ambulance Service Fees. Billing and collection services ambulance service fees are submitted to Medicare, private insurance, or other applicable providers by a private billing agency. Prehospital data must be processed prior to submitting billing information to the billing agency. The City is looking to contract with the City of Sedro Woolley for these billing preparation services.
