SUMMARY

Berry Dairy Days Festival and Grand Parade Special Event Permit and Street Closure Request:
 The Burlington Chamber of Commerce is requesting approval for street closures for the Annual Berry Dairy Days Festival and Grand Parade. City staff met with the Chamber staff and reviewed and approved all the proposed road closures. (Parks & Recreation, Fire, Police, Public Works)

New this year, the Festival will be two-days, Saturday, June 15 – Sunday, June 16, 2019. The Festival is expanding its footprint as well, taking place at the Visitor Information Center (VIC) Amphitheater and surrounding side streets, Oak Street, Fairhaven Avenue and S Cherry Street. Saturday's activities will be similar to past years, Kids Zone, Strawberry Shortcake, food booths, live music and vendors. These activities will continue into Sunday with the addition of a BBQ Battle along Fairhaven Ave. The Grand Parade will take place along its usual route, E. Fairhaven Avenue on Saturday, June 15.

- Berry Cool Car Show Street Closure Request: The Cascade Street Rod Association is requesting street closures for the annual "Berry Cool Car Show" to take place on Sunday, June 16, 2019.
 There are no changes from past years; the car show will take place on E. Fairhaven Avenue.

SUMMARY

The 2019 Festival's budget includes \$10,000 and the Lodging Tax Grant provided an additional \$2,000 for a total of \$12,000 for a firework show at the Berry Dairy Days event on Friday, June 14, 2019. Staff developed a Request for Proposal for a fireworks display with four (4) bids being submitted. The City staff reviewed the bids and selected Western Display Fireworks to provide the show for the 2019 Berry Dairy Days event. This is the same vendor as 2018 and they managed a well-organized and professional show. Included with the RFP and contract this year is a clause that if all goes well and there are no issues, the City and Western Display have an option to roll-over the contract for 2020.

Western Display, whom has 66yrs of experience, submitted a proposal that provided 95 additional fireworks shells than the next highest bidder. Western Display Fireworks designed a custom 20 minute fireworks display, others mentioned "approximately" up to 20 minute show. Western Display provides over 100 shows per year including displays for Seafair, Mukilteo Lighthouse Festival, Oak Harbor NYE & 4th of July Celebrations, Macy's Starlight Celebration, among others. Their proposal was the most complete and accurate.

RECOMMENDATION

Council Motion to award the fireworks agreement to Western Display Fireworks for the 2019 Berry Dairy Days event and approve the agreement and authorize the Mayor to sign.
