HISTORY AND SUMMARY

On March 13, 2020 the City of Burlington used the MRSC Roster to solicit bids for a sewer pump replacement. We received and opened two bids on March 31, 2020. The low bid was received from Whitney Equipment Company, located in Woodinville, WA for the amount \$64,730.02 including tax. A second bid was received from Cascade Machinery located in Seattle, WA for the amount of \$88,675.97 including tax. This is to replace a pump at Pump Station #8 located at Peterson Rd. and Avon Allen Rd.. This pump station moves the entire product from the Bayview Ridge area about 6 miles through a 20" line to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The pump installation will be handled in-house by the City's Sewer Department staff.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

This is a critical pump station that moves about 350,000 gallons a day. Without replacement, the City risks backing up sewage into residences served by this sewer pump station.

CURRENT AND FUTURE BUDGET RAMIFICATIONS

This purchase is within the expected range of routine maintenance activities for our sewer collection system and we have adequate budget to cover this expense in line item 402-000-594-35-64-20 Sewer Machinery & Equipment.
