HISTORY AND SUMMARY

Since 2010 the Burlington Public Library has had an interlocal agreement with three other Skagit libraries (LaConner Regional Library, Upper Skagit Library District, and Hospice of the Northwest) related to Evergreen, our shared ILS (Integrated Library System) – the automated system that runs all our library processes. We have now updated that agreement to better reflect the current relationship we have with these other libraries. The primary change is that we will now contract with Equinox Services to provide technical support, upgrades, and hosting services. Equinox Services is a library service provider that works exclusively with libraries that have open-source ILS systems—which is what our current Evergreen library system is. Previously these hosting services have been provided by the City of Burlington; the change provides a cost savings, it will eliminate some stress on the City of Burlington IT Department, and will provide evening and Saturday support (which the city IT staff aren't equipped to provide).

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

The alternative is to continue with the current, outdated agreement.

CURRENT AND FUTURE BUDGET RAMIFICATIONS

Switching to Equinox hosting will provide a savings to the City of Burlington of \$1,260 per year, which is an annual savings of 12%.

LEGAL ASPECTS – LEGAL REVIEW

City Attorney, Leif Johnson, worked with library staff to create this updated Professional Services Interlocal Agreement.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The library staff recommends updating the interlocal agreement. The current agreement is 10 years old and long overdue for revisions. Also, the upgrade to Equinox Services hosting will be a cost savings and offer hosting and support by a provider who specializes in open-source systems and is able to offer technical support during library evening and weekend hours. In addition, if the council approves the updated interlocal agreement and upgrade to Equinox Services hosting at this time, the upgrade can be implemented while the library is still closed to the public—which means there will be less disruption to the public and day-to-day library operations.

SUGGESTED COUNCIL MOTION LANGUAGE

I move to approve the updated Interlocal Professional Services Agreement between Burlington Public Library, LaConner Regional Library, Upper Skagit Library District, and Hospice of the Northwest and authorize the mayor to sign the agreement.
